Concerning the travel expenses:

If you pay for the expenses yourself - use the standard "Statement of Charges" supported by original documents, attached to this mail.

You have to fill in a special expense note with all details (your bank details, address details,...) and send it (original document, not scan copy) together with:

- copy of the electronic flight reservation (where the amount of the ticket is mentioned) + CCard payment copy
- original boarding passes
- original hotel invoice (with proof of payment)

If the Host institution is paying the expenses for you, an invoice/statement from this institution is the preferred (only) way. This to ensure that we have accurate payment information of the institution and to make sure that the money is arriving at the right place within the host institution when we are making the money transfer. When the institution is sending an invoice, only copies of the supporting documents are required.
